ACCOMODATION IN RIAD , HOTEL 4 AND 5 STARS



1 ° ITINERARY - 14 days

•Day 1: Arrival in Casablanca

When you arrive at Casablanca Airport, your driver will be waiting for you with a sign that has your name on it. From there, you will be transferred to your hotel. If you arrive early, you can visit the famous **Hassan II Mosque**, one of the largest mosques in the world, or enjoy a relaxing walk along the **Corniche** by the ocean.

•Day 2: Casablanca – Rabat

After breakfast, we will leave Casablanca and drive to Rabat, the capital of Morocco. you will visit the **Hassan Tower**, a tall minaret that was never finished, and the **Mausoleum of Mohammed V**, a royal tomb with beautiful Moroccan design. You will also explore the **Kasbah of Les Oudayas**, an old area with white-and-blue houses and views of the river. After the visit, we will take you to your hotel where you can relax for the evening.

•Day 3: Rabat – Tangier

Today, we continue our journey north to Tangier, a city where the Atlantic Ocean meets the Mediterranean Sea.

Once you arrive, you will visit the famous **Cave of Hercules**, a natural cave with stunning ocean views and local legends. You can walk through the **old medina**, see the port, and visit some of the city's famous spots. Tangier is where the Atlantic Ocean meets the Mediterranean Sea, and it has a special mix of European and Moroccan charm.

Afterward, transfer to your hotel and free time to relax.

•Day 4: Tangier to Chefchaouen.

After discovering Tangier. We will travel to Chefchaouen. Once you arrive, you can walk through the blue streets, take pictures, and enjoy the peaceful atmosphere.

You can start by visiting **Outa El Hammam**, the main square in the old city. It is a great place to sit, relax, and enjoy the street performers.

Then, you can walk **to Ras El Ma**, a small waterfall just outside the city walls. It is a quiet place where you can enjoy fresh mountain air and the sound of running water.

You can visit the **Kasbah Museum**. It is inside an old fortress and shows local history, traditional clothes, and Berber culture.

•Day 5: Chefchaouen to Fes via Volubilis.

Around 9 or 10 am, we will leave Chefchaouen and begin our journey to Fes. On the way, we will stop at two important places.

Our first stop is **Volubilis, an old Roman city** with ruins. You can walk through the stone streets, see the mosaic floors, and take pictures of the ancient buildings.

After that, we will drive to **Meknes**, one of Morocco's imperial cities. Here, you can visit the famous **Bab Mansour** gate and see the old walls, markets, and royal buildings.

In the late afternoon, we will arrive in Fes. We will take you to the riad, where you can rest and get ready for the guided tour of Fes the next day.

•Day 6: Fes guided tour.

Today, you will explore the old city of Fes with a local guide. The tour starts at the **Royal Palace**, where you will see the golden doors. Then, you will visit the **Jewish Quarter**, known as the Mellah, before heading to a viewpoint that overlooks the entire medina.

Next, you will enter the historic medina, a UNESCO World Heritage site. Inside, you will visit the **Al-Qarawiyyin University**, the oldest in the world, and the **Al-Attarine Madrasa**, known for its detailed tile work. You will also stop by the **Nejjarine Fountain** and explore the **Chouara Tannery**, where leather is dyed using traditional methods.

Along the way, you will see local artisans making pottery, carpets, and metal crafts. You will have free time on your own after the guide drops you off at the riad.

•Day 7: Fes to Merzouga desert.

Today, you will travel from Fes to Merzouga, passing through beautiful and interesting places.

The first stop is Ifrane, a clean city known as the "Switzerland of Morocco." Here, you will see the famous **Atlas lion statue**, a popular photo spot.

Next, you will visit the **Cedar Forest near Azrou**, where you can see wild Barbary monkeys in the trees. We then drive through **Midelt and stop at the Hassan Addakhil Dam near Errachidia**. The blue water and mountain views make it a great place for photos.

After that, we continue to the **Ziz Valley**, known for its palm trees. You can stop to enjoy the view and take pictures.

In the afternoon, you will arrive in **Merzouga**. From here, you will start your camel ride across the **golden dunes of Erg Chebbi**. You will stop to enjoy the sunset before arriving at your desert camp.

In the evening, you will have dinner, listen to traditional music, and spend the night under the stars.

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•Day 8: Merzouga to Dades.

Sunrise over the dunes is something you should not miss. After breakfast at the camp, we will leave the desert and drive to **Rissani**, a town that was once a busy stop for caravans that used to trade. Today, Rissani is home to one of the largest markets in the desert region, where locals buy and sell fruits, spices, clothes, and even animals like donkeys and goats.

After exploring the market, **we will continue to Fezna to visit the old underground irrigation system. These small tunnels were built long ago to bring water from the mountains to farms in the desert, and they are still impressive to see today.**

Next, we will stop at a **Berber women's cooperative**. The women are friendly and will show you their handmade crafts. If you like, they will dress you in traditional Berber clothes for fun photos and offer free henna designs.

In the afternoon, we will drive to the **Todra Gorges**. These tall cliffs rise high on both sides of a narrow path with a river at the bottom. It is a great place to walk, take photos, and enjoy the fresh air.

By the end of the day, we will reach **Dades**, where you will spend the night.

•Day 9: Dades to Marrakech.

After breakfast in Dades, we will drive to Marrakech and visit different attractions on the way.

First, we will pass through the **Rose Valley**, known for its rose farms and rose products. Then, we stop in **Skoura to see the Amridil Kasbah, a traditional mud-brick Kasbah** that shows how people lived in the past.

Next, we will visit **Ouarzazate**, called the "Hollywood of Africa." You will explore the Atlas Studio, where many movies and shows were filmed.

After that, we will go to **Ait Benhaddou, a famous old Kasbah made of clay**. It is a UNESCO site and has been in many films. You can walk to the top for great views.

Later, we drive through the **High Atlas Mountains** and cross the **Tizi n'Tichka Pass**, with beautiful views of the High Atlas Mountains.

In the evening, we will arrive in Marrakech, where you will spend the night.

•Day 10: Marrakech guided tour.

Today you will explore Marrakech with a local guide. You will start at the 12th-century **Koutoubia Mosque, whose tall minaret** is visible from much of the city.

Next, you will visit the 19th-century **Bahia Palace**, with its graceful rooms, gardens, and Moroccan décor that reflects how wealthy families once lived.

Then you will see the **Saadian Tombs**, the 16th-century resting place of the Saadian dynasty, sealed for years and rediscovered in 1917.

Later, you will wander the souks of the old city—lively lanes full of color and scent, with stalls selling spices, handmade crafts, carpets, and traditional clothing. These markets have been part of Marrakech life for centuries.

After you discover Marrakech, you can continue exploring on your own or return to your hotel to relax.

•Day 11: Free day in Marrakech (hot air balloon or Hammam)

Today is a free day to enjoy Marrakech at your own pace.

You can choose to take a **hot air balloon ride** early in the morning for a unique experience over the landscapes. You can also relax in a traditional hammam and spa.

Alternatively, you can explore more of the medina or enjoy a café in **Jemaa el-Fnaa square**.

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•Day 12: Marrakech to Essaouira.

Today, we will drive from Marrakech to Essaouira, a trip that takes about 3 hours. Once we arrive in Essaouira, you will have free time to explore the city. You can visit the old fishing port, walk along the city walls known as **the Sqala, and enjoy the calm streets of the old medina.** You can also relax by the beach, feel the ocean breeze, or try some fresh seafood. Essaouira has a peaceful atmosphere and is a great place to enjoy your afternoon.

•Day 13: Essaouira to Casablanca.

After a free morning in Essaouira, where you can enjoy a final walk through the medina or relax by the beach, we will drive along the Atlantic coast back to Casablanca. The road offers nice ocean views and passes through small coastal cities. Once we arrive in Casablanca, you will check into your hotel and enjoy your last evening in Morocco. You can take a walk along the Corniche, have a nice dinner, or simply relax and get ready for your flight the next day.

•Day 14: Transfer to the airport.

This will be the last day of our tour. Our driver will take you to the airport to catch your flight.



2° iTINERARY : 8 days

Day 1: Arrival in Casablanca.

The tour starts by picking you up from the airport. We will take you to the hotel to check in. If you arrive early, we will take you to visit some attractions.

- **Day 2: Casablanca - Rif Mountains - Chefchaouen.**

On the second day of the trip, we leave Casablanca towards the North of Morocco through the Rif Mountains. We will make several stops for Panoramic views, a bathroom, and to stretch our legs. By the afternoon, we will arrive in Chefchaouen, the blue city of Morocco. First, we will take you to check into your accommodation and leave your luggage. After that, you will have free time to walk through the blue streets and explore the medina. You can start by heading to the square of Utat Lhmam in the city center for lunch. Then, you can get to the Kasbah, the oldest building in Chefchaouen, which dates back to the 15th century.

By evening, we recommend hiking up to the Spanish mosque for sunset and the panoramic view of the blue city

- **Day 3: Chefchaouen - Fes Guided Tour.**

Today, we recommend waking up early for a morning walk through the blue streets, as the city is usually less busy at this time. Then, after breakfast, we leave Chefchaouen and travel toward Fes. The road takes us through the Rif mountains before reaching the spiritual and cultural capital of Morocco. Upon arrival in Fes, you will meet your local guide and start exploring the city. First, we will drive to visit the Royal Palace with its 7 silver gates, which is a great example of Moroccan architecture. Then, we will drive through the Mellah quarter to Borj Sud for the Panoramic view of the old city. Next, we will have a final drive to the Pottery Cooperative to learn about how traditional Moroccan pottery is made. You will see skilled artisans shaping, painting, and firing clay pieces by hand, using techniques passed down through generations.

The second part of our city tour is done walking with the local guide through the narrow alleys of the old Madina. Here, you will explore unique landmarks like the Al Quaraouiyyine University (the oldest in the world), the Bou Inania Madrasa, and the Chouara tanneries, where they dye leather using traditional techniques.

Finally, after the walking tour, we will take you to your accommodation. Free evening on your own, you can head to the Blue Gate for a short walk.

- **Day 4: Fes - Ifrane - Cedar Forest - Merzouga - Camel Trekking - Camping.**

Today, we are heading south through the Middle Atlas Mountains. First, we will stop at the little Switzerland of Morocco, Ifrane. Enjoy a morning walk around the city and discover the Atlas Lion Statue. After that, we will drive across the Cedar Forest near the ski resort of Michlifén. Here, we will stop to see the friendly Barbary monkeys.

Afterwards, we will pass by the open wide fields and hills of the Atlas mountains, home to the Berber nomads with their sheep and goats. These families move across the land in search of better living conditions.

Next, we will cross the High Atlas Mountains through the Tizi n'Talghomt Pass, which stands at 1,917 meters above sea level. The next stop will be in Ziz Valley, one of the biggest sources of dates in Morocco, with endless palm groves.

We continue our trip towards Erg Chebbi dunes, the beginning of the grand Sahara Desert that covers 11 countries. We will start our desert adventure with a camel ride across the desert and make a stop on top of a big dune to watch the sunset.

After an amazing sunset over the dunes, we will head to the desert camp, check into your tent, have Dinner, and gather around the campfire to enjoy traditional drumming. You will also have free time to

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enjoy the starry sky.

- **Day 5: Merzouga - Rissani - Todra Gorges - Dades Gorges.**

On the fifth day of the 8-day tour from Casablanca, we recommend waking up early today to enjoy the sunrise over the dunes. The desert is very peaceful in the morning, and the golden light makes the landscape even more beautiful.

First, after breakfast at the camp, we leave Merzouga and head to Rissani, one of the largest souks in southern Morocco. This is where locals from nearby villages, including the desert, come to buy and sell goods. You will enjoy a walk through the Souk, see the animal market, the desert spices, where they sell clothes, vegetables, and where they park their donkeys.

Afterwards, we will drive through many Berber villages, desert Oases, and Valleys toward the Todra Gorges. These tall rock cliffs are a nice break during the day. You will have free time to walk near the river and explore the area.

Finally, we drive to Boumalne Dades, where we will explore the famous rock formations known as the "Monkey Toes" and then head to the panoramic view of the winding road of Tissdrine.

Overnight in the Dades Gorges.

- **Day 6: Dades Gorges - Rose Valley - Ouarzazate - Ait Benhaddou - Marrakech.**

After breakfast, we will hit the road towards Marrakech. First, we will cross the Rose Valley, a region known for growing Damascus roses. Here, we can make a stop to see one of the cooperatives where they extract the rose water and use it for cosmetic products. After that, we will continue through the Skoura oasis and the One Thousand Kasbahs Route.

Our next destination is Ouarzazate, the Hollywood of Africa. We will visit the Atlas Film Studios, where many famous movies and series were filmed.

Afterwards, we will travel to the Kasbah of Ait Benhaddou, the most famous fortress in Morocco. We will hike up to the top of the Kasbah, where you can enjoy views of the surrounding mountains, valleys, and desert landscapes.

After having lunch, we drive through the High Atlas Mountains via Tichka Pass and make a stop at the highest point of the road, at 2,260 meters above sea level.

Finally, we will drive down to Marrakech and check into your accommodation. Free evening to walk around the square of Jamaa El Fna for dinner.

- **Day 7: Marrakech Guided Tour.**

Today, you will explore Marrakech with a local guide. The tour starts from your accommodation with a walk through Jamaa El Fna square, the beating heart of Marrakech. Enjoy the street performers, the snake charmers, and food stalls. Next, we will walk deeper into the old medina to visit the Madrasa Ben Youssef, the Bahia & Badi palaces. Then, we will continue the walk through the Mellah quarter to visit the Saadian tombs before heading to the Koutoubia mosque.

After you finish the walking tour, we will take the car and drive to the new city to visit the Majorelle garden.

Finally, we will drop you off back to your accommodation to relax. You will have a free evening to walk around the square or try a Moroccan Hammam.

- **Day 8: Transfer to the Airport.**

On the last day of our trip, we will drop you off at Marrakech or Casablanca airport to catch your flight. End of the 8-day Morocco tour.



3° ITINERARY – 8 days

Day 1: 25 April 2027, Sunday – Arrival in Casablanca

Flight arrives at Casablanca Airport at 15:00.

The first day of the Morocco luxury tour starts by picking up the group from Casablanca Airport. Your English-speaking guide/assistant will be waiting for the group after the passport control and luggage collection.

After meeting the group, we will transfer to Casablanca city by private bus with A/C, microphone, and enough space for suitcases. The drive from the airport to the city center takes around 45 minutes, depending on traffic.

Distance: around 35 km

Driving time: around 45 minutes

If time allows, we will start with a short panoramic tour of Casablanca. We will enjoy a walk along the Ain Diab Corniche, one of the most famous seaside areas in the city. After that, we will make a photo stop at the Hassan II Mosque, one of the most important monuments in Morocco and the largest mosque in the country.

Depending on the arrival time and traffic, we can also pass by the city center, the United Nations Square, Mohammed V Square, and the old medina from outside.

After the visit, we will transfer to the hotel for check-in. The guide will assist the group with the check-in.

Dinner will be served at the hotel. If the agency prefers an outside restaurant, we can suggest a suitable restaurant close to the hotel by bus or by walking distance, depending on the final hotel confirmed.

Accommodation in Casablanca.

Meal plan: Dinner and breakfast included.

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- **Day 2: 26 April 2027, Monday – Casablanca – Rabat – Volubilis – Meknes – Fes**

After breakfast at the hotel, we will check out and start the journey towards Fes.

We recommend leaving Casablanca at 08:00 to make the day more comfortable, because this is one of the longest cultural days of the tour.

First, we will drive to Rabat, the capital city of Morocco. The drive takes around 1 hour and 15 minutes.

When we arrive in Rabat, we will start the guided visit with the Hassan Tower, an unfinished minaret from the 12th century. Next to it, you will visit the Mausoleum of Mohammed V, known for its beautiful Moroccan architecture and royal history.

After that, we will visit the Kasbah of the Oudayas, a peaceful old quarter with narrow streets, white-and-blue houses, and beautiful views over the Bou Regreg River and the Atlantic Ocean.

After the visit, we will stop for lunch in Rabat. A good option can be a traditional Moroccan restaurant suitable for groups, with easy bus access. Dar Naji or Similar. Lunch included.

After lunch, we continue the journey towards Meknes and Volubilis, the old Roman site of Morocco. On the way, we can make a short WC and coffee stop at a service station.

We will drive through Meknes, the group can stop for photos at Bab Mansour, one of the most beautiful gates in Morocco, and see part of the old imperial city walls (to be planned on that day, depending on how we do on timing).

Afterwards, we will drive to Volubilis. Here, the group will visit the Roman ruins with a local guide from the place. You will walk through the old stone streets, see the mosaic floors, and learn about the Roman history of Morocco.

Arrival in Fes will be in the evening. We will take the group to the hotel or luxury riad for check-in. The rest of the evening is free.

Accommodation in Fes.

Meal plan: Breakfast and Lunch included. Dinner on the clients' own or optional.

- **Day 3: 27 April 2027, Tuesday – Fes Guided Tour**

After breakfast at the hotel, we will start the guided tour of Fes with a local cultural guide.

Fes is one of the oldest and most important imperial cities in Morocco. The tour starts by visiting the Royal Palace gate, known for its golden doors and beautiful Moroccan design. After that, we will walk through the Jewish Quarter, called the Mellah, and learn about the history of the Jewish community in Fes.

Next, we will drive to a panoramic viewpoint that overlooks the entire medina. This is a good place for photos before entering the old city.

Afterward, we will visit a ceramic workshop to see one of the most famous crafts of Fes. You will see how Moroccan tiles, pottery, and mosaics are made by hand.

Then, we will enter the historic medina of Fes, a UNESCO World Heritage site. Inside the medina, the group will walk through narrow streets, traditional markets, and old neighborhoods full of history.

During the walking tour, you will visit or see the Al-Qarawiyyin University from outside, one of the oldest universities in the world. You will also visit the Al-Attarine Madrasa or Bou Inania Madrasa, depending on the opening situation. Furthermore, you will stop by the Nejjarine Fountain and visit the famous Chouara Tannery, where leather is still prepared and dyed in the traditional way.

Lunch will be in a suitable restaurant inside or near the medina.

After lunch, we continue the visit depending on the rhythm of the group. We will make sure there is at least 2 hours of free time after the guided tour so clients can explore, shop, or relax on their own.

Around 17:00, we will transfer the group back to the hotel. We can also transfer the group to the accommodation to relax after the guided tour, then they would have free time to walk around the medina on their own.

Accommodation in Fes.

Meal plan: Breakfast and Lunch included. Dinner on the clients' own.

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- **Day 4: 28 April 2027, Wednesday – Fes – Ifrane – Cedar Forest – Midelt – Ziz Valley – Merzouga Desert**

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After breakfast at the hotel, we will leave Fes at 07:30 towards the Sahara desert of Merzouga.

We will start the day by driving through the Middle Atlas Mountains. Our first stop will be in Ifrane, a clean mountain town known for its European-style architecture. Here, we will stop at the famous Atlas Lion statue for photos, a short walk and WC.

After Ifrane, we continue to the cedar forest near Azrou. Here, the group can enjoy a short walk and see the wild Barbary monkeys.

Then, we continue towards Midelt, a town located between the Middle Atlas and High Atlas mountains. We will stop for lunch in Midelt or nearby, in a suitable restaurant for groups.

After lunch, we continue the road through the mountains and the Ziz Gorges. Near Errachidia, we can make a photo stop at the Hassan Addakhil Dam if the timing allows.

After that, we will stop at the panoramic view of Ziz Valley, known for its long palm groves and traditional Berber villages.

In the late afternoon, we continue south towards Erfoud and Merzouga, the gateway to the Erg Chebbi dunes.

When we arrive in Merzouga, the group will meet the camel team and start the camel ride across the golden dunes. We will stop in the dunes to enjoy the sunset before reaching the luxury desert camp. For clients who do not want to ride camels, transfer to the camp by 4x4 is possible. Luggage will be transferred separately to the camp.

At the camp, the group will check into private luxury tents with private bathrooms. Dinner will be served at the camp. After dinner, the group can enjoy Berber music around the campfire and have free time for stargazing.

Accommodation in luxury desert camp.

Meal plan: Breakfast, lunch, and dinner included.

- **Day 5: 29 April 2027, Thursday – Merzouga Desert Free Day (optional 4x4 Offroad tour)**

We recommend waking up early to watch the sunrise over the dunes. This is one of the most beautiful moments in the Sahara Desert, with calm light and peaceful views.

After sunrise, the group will return to the camp for breakfast.

This day is planned as a free day at leisure in the desert. The group can relax at the camp, enjoy the silence of the Sahara, walk around the dunes, or take photos.

Depending on the camp arrangement, lunch included, including Berber Pizza (Madfouna).

Clients can enjoy optional desert activities with 4x4s.

- -4x4 excursion around Erg Chebbi dunes. (4 pax each)
- -Visit to Khamlia village to enjoy Gnawa music
- -Visit to a nomad family in the desert
- -Visit Desert Oasis
- -Quad biking tour in the dunes.
- -Sandboarding: Included.
- -Cooking class or tea ceremony at the camp
- -Short camel ride for sunset
- -Visit to Rissani market, depending on the market day and timing

Optional activities can be quoted separately once the agency confirms which activities they want to include.

Dinner will be served at the camp. The evening is free to enjoy the desert atmosphere.

Accommodation in luxury desert camp.

Meal plan: Breakfast, Lunch, and dinner included.

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- **Day 6: 30 April 2027, Friday – Merzouga – Todra Gorges – Rose Valley – Skoura – Ouarzazate**

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After breakfast at the camp, we will leave the Sahara Desert and drive towards Ouarzazate.

First, we will drive through Erfoud and Tinghir before reaching Todra Gorges. These are among the most beautiful canyons in Morocco, with high rock walls and a peaceful river. The group will have time for a relaxed walk inside the gorge and photos.

After the visit, we continue towards the Dades region and the Rose Valley. Lunch stop will be on the way, in Tinghir, Kelaat M'Gouna, or Skoura, depending on timing.

In Skoura, we will visit Amridil Kasbah, one of the most famous kasbahs in southern Morocco. The group will learn about the traditional architecture of the region and the old way of life in the kasbah.

After the visit, we continue to Ouarzazate.

Skoura to Ouarzazate: around 40 km

Driving time: around 1 hour

Arrival in Ouarzazate will be in the evening. Because this is a long day, we recommend keeping the evening free and not adding a full city tour.

If time allows, we can make a short panoramic visit or photo stop near Taourirt Kasbah before check-in.

Otherwise, the Ouarzazate visits can be done the next morning.

Total distance of the day: around 390 km

Total driving time: around 7 hours, not including visits and stops

Accommodation in Ouarzazate.

Meal plan: Dinner and Breakfast and Lunch included.

- **Day 7: 1 May 2027, Saturday – Ouarzazate – Atlas Studios – Ait Benhaddou – High Atlas Mountains – Marrakech**

After breakfast at the hotel, we will start the day with a visit to Ouarzazate, known as the cinema city of Morocco.

We recommend starting around 08:30.

First, we can visit Atlas Studios, where many international movies were filmed. The visit is usually done with the studio's internal guide. Entrance fees included.

After that, we continued to Ait Benhaddou, the most famous kasbah village in Morocco and a UNESCO World Heritage site.

In Ait Benhaddou, the group will walk through the old ksar. You will see the traditional clay architecture, the old houses, and the hilltop view over the valley. This village was an important stop for camel caravans in the past and has also been used as a filming location for many movies.

After the visit, lunch will be at a suitable restaurant near Ait Benhaddou, such as Maison d'Hôte Chez Brahim or a similar group-friendly restaurant. Drinks are not included.

After lunch, we will start the drive to Marrakech. The road crosses the High Atlas Mountains through the Tizi n'Tichka Pass. Along the way, we will make photo stops for mountain views and Berber villages.

Arrival in Marrakech will be in the early evening. We will transfer the group to the hotel for check-in.

Optional dinner: Traditional Moroccan dinner in Marrakech with transfers from/to the hotel.

Optional evening: Fantasia Chez Ali dinner show with transfers from/to the hotel. This is outside Marrakech and can be quoted separately for minimum 10 pax.

Meal plan: Breakfast and Lunch included. Dinner on the clients' own or optional.

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- **Day 8: 2 May 2027, Sunday – Marrakech Guided Tour – Airport Transfer**

After breakfast at the hotel, we will start the guided tour of Marrakech with a local cultural guide.

The tour starts around 09:00 and lasts around 5 hours.

We recommend starting the tour with a visit to the old city. We will visit the Koutoubia Mosque from the outside, the largest mosque in Marrakech and one of the symbols of the city. Then, we will walk through the famous Jemaa El Fna square, known for its lively atmosphere, storytellers, musicians, and traditional markets.

Next, we will visit the Medrassa ben Youssef and the Bahia Palace, one of the most beautiful palaces in Marrakech, known for its courtyards, Moroccan tiles, and decorated ceilings. We will also visit the Saadian Tombs, an important historical site from the Saadian dynasty.

Lunch can be planned in the old city of Marrakech at a suitable place.

Next, we will visit the Jardin Majorelle and the Berber Museum. This visit should be booked in advance because entrance slots can be limited.

After that, we can head back to the old city for some free time for the group to walk around the old city on their own and enjoy the lively atmosphere of Jamaa EL Fna Square.

At 20:00, we will transfer the group to Marrakech Airport for flight departing at 22:45.

Driving time: around 15–25 minutes, depending on traffic
